

"We do not inherit the earth from our ancestors; we borrow it from our children."



At Altro we are committed to sourcing our raw materials sustainably and broadening our thinking beyond these raw materials to consider how we can secure for the future other critical supply chains too. This will ensure a future-proof, sustainable supply of high quality materials.

- The global Altro floors portfolio contains up to 30% recycled content, the exact figure varies per range.
- Altro PVC-based and resin floor and wall products are manufactured using the highest quality materials.
- Our safety floors and walls do not contain formaldehyde.
- Our safety floors and walls do not contain lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium We are members of VinylPlus.







Manufacturing

The Altro process

Altro's manufacturing processes are designed to not only ensure the safety and well-being of our staff but environmental well-being too, by looking at renewable material sources, product performance and end of life disposal.

- Altro invented adhesive-free safety flooring, allowing the product to be recycled or reused
- Altro were the first manufacturer to produce phthalate-free safety floors
- We continue to lead the market in making vinyl floors that are free from ortho-phthalate plasticisers
- We have been using a more renewable source of plasticisers since 2008 globally
- 100% of Altro construction safety floors contain a bioplasticiser which comes from corn/maize
- We use plasticisers based on natural raw materials (citric acid ester)
- All Altro vinyl floors are CE compliant according to EN 14041:2004/AC:2006

Ensuring wellbeing

VOCs are volatile organic compounds that are released into the atmosphere by some substances and products. It is thought that exposure to VOCs can cause problems like sick building syndrome, diminished learning in schools, and reduced productivity in offices. Altro Whiterock™ recycling scheme

Altro partnered with VEKA Recycling to set up the UK's first wall cladding recycling scheme, Recowall, which is unique in the PVCu wall cladding sector. Altro place bins at Altro Whiterock Premier Installer sites around the UK, where contractors can deposit clean, adhesive-free off cuts and thermoformed corners from site.

Recovering material





Altro are co-founder members of Recofloor the industry's vinyl take back scheme which collects safety and smooth vinyl off cuts and uplifted smooth vinyl, and diverts them from landfill.

Eliminating waste
